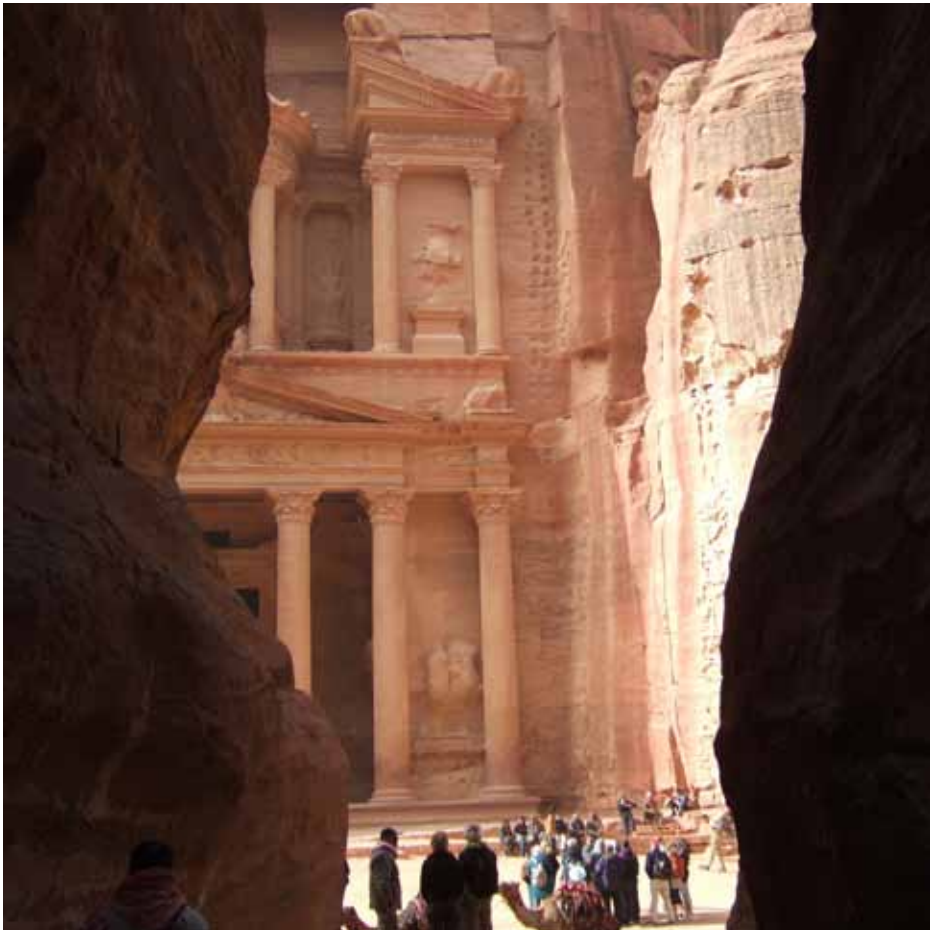

We start with a busy few days in Jordan, exploring Wadi Rum and Petra, two very iconic destinations.

The second half of the trip will be more chilled out, in a lovely hotel on the Sea of Galilee. There will be outings to some significant Biblical and historical sites, as well as plenty of time to relax by the pool, enjoy the stunning view or walk into Tiberias.

A major feature of the trip will be time for Bible teaching in the evenings, to feed our minds and our souls.

We designed this trip to tick a number of holiday boxes:

- *Petra is an adventure on many people's bucket list*
- *Galilee has important and meaningful biblical sites*
- *The pace will allow for 'rest by Galilee' and 'calm of hills above'*

Day 1 - Thursday

We depart from London Heathrow on our flight to Tel Aviv and onward to Eilat. Dinner and overnight Eilat.



Day 2 - Friday

We drive to Arava border and cross to Jordan. We visit Wadi Rum where we spend a good half-day including lunch and 2 hrs jeep ride. Dinner and overnight in Petra.

Day 3 - Saturday

Full day guided tour of Petra. Dinner and overnight Petra.

Day 4 - Sunday

Free day in Petra includes second entrance fee, one group transfer to and from site, but no guide. Dinner and overnight Petra.

Day 5 - Monday

We leave Petra and drive to Mt Nebo, from where Moses viewed the Promised Land.

Continue to the Sheikh Hussein Bridge and cross to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 - Tuesday

Free day to relax by the lakeside and evening boat trip on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight Tiberias.

Day 7 - Wednesday

Visit Magdala, Capernaum, Tabgha and Mount of Beatitudes with time to wander back down to the lakeside. Dinner and overnight Tiberias.

Day 8 - Thursday

Visit Caesarea Philippi, the source of the River Jordan. Then drive to the Golan Heights for a visit (there may also be opportunity for a 4 x 4 jeep ride which the guide will be able to book in advance - extra charge). Return to hotel and remainder of the day is free. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 9 - Friday

Morning boat trip on the Sea of Galilee. Remainder of the day is free. Dinner and overnight Tiberias.



Day 10 - Saturday

Leave Tiberias and transfer to Ben Gurion airport including some sightseeing en route. Return flight home to London Heathrow.

Passports, visas and vaccinations

Travellers are responsible for ensuring that they have a valid passport for travel to the relevant countries and that it is valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel. Visas are required for British passport holders visiting Jordan but not for Israel. Details of how to obtain this will be sent with your final invoice. At the time this brochure went to press no vaccinations or inoculations are required for travel

but you may wish to consult your own doctor for advice concerning this. If you have any queries regarding the above, we will be happy to help.

Further information and paying the balance

Further information will be sent to you regarding any action that may be required approximately 12 weeks before departure.

A final invoice will also be sent at this time and the balance for the tour must be paid at least 10 weeks before departure.

Travel information

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties.

Travel insurance

It is compulsory to have travel insurance for your booking. Holiday Extras have a range of policies available at very competitive prices.

Gratuities

Our normal procedure is to deal with tips on a group basis and these are included in the price. The tour leader will distribute them to the guide, driver and hotels on your behalf. Individual tipping is not recommended unless the circumstances are exceptional.

Room check in and check out times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 11am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.
