## 2019 Itinerary

Day 1 - Monday 29th July

Day flight from Luton to Tel Aviv. Overnight in Jerusalem - 3\* hotel.



# Day 2 - Tuesday 30th

We start at the excavated ruins of the City of David to uncover the secrets of biblical Jerusalem; walk in the footsteps of kings and prophets at the site where many of the stories of the Bible took place. For those wanting a challenge we walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel, carved out of solid rock to bring water into the city in 716 B.C. It's wet and dark, but great fun. The tunnel comes out at the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus told the blind man to wash his eyes and he would see. Ascend by way of the Herodian Channel that comes out by the Western Wall at the foot of the Temple Mount. Next the Davidson **Centre** for a film presentation of Jerusalem in the time of Jesus. Out into the sunshine and short tour of the



**Southern Wall Excavations** of the Temple Mount to stand on the steps Jesus took to enter the temple.

Lunch time in the Jewish Quarter.

The Mount of Olives with its spectacular views across the Kidron Valley the Tomb of the Prophet's and Jerusalem. From here we walk down Palm Sunday Road retracing Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem and visiting Dominus Flavit (where Jesus wept



over Jerusalem) before descending into the **Garden of Gethsemane** to consider his last 24 hours.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

## Day 3 - Wednesday 31st

We enter the **Old City** through **St Stephen's Gate** a possible location of his stoning and visit the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus healed the crippled man. We travel back through history walking the streets of **Old Jerusalem** and the **Via Dolorosa** to the **Western Wall** (Kotel) where you can pray, or just absorb the atmosphere of this unique place.

Lunch time in the Old City.

An uphill walk through the upper city gate to the **Church of St Peter** on Mount Zion where Peter denied his friend Jesus three times. From here we can see the original steps Jesus walked up from the City of David to the **House of Caiaphas** 

the High Priest.

Optional - For those interested in modern history we get a fascinating insight into the British Mandate period 1917 – 48 with a visit to the **Underground Prisoner Museum**. The British prison held those thought to be a threat by the Mandatory



government, particularly members of the pre-state Jewish underground. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

After dinner we visit Friends of Zion Museum where we meet the biblical figures, academics, businessmen, and military officials who, through their faith, have forged an everlasting bond between the Jewish and Christian peoples.

Magnificently told using ground-breaking technology, accompanied by original musical score, fantastic surround sound, lighting second-to-none and interactive displays that appear to come to life before your very eyes.



# Day 4 - Thursday 1st August

Today starts at the **Garden Tomb** and the **Place of the Skull** where we consider the importance of what took place here. Always a powerful and moving experience.

A short drive through West Jerusalem to **Yad Vashem** the Holocaust Memorial Museum, a must for all visitors to Israel. This special experience shows God's hand on the Jewish people and their Nation.

We journey south to the Judean desert, where those wanting to make the most of the desert experience will take a short trek into the wilderness. If this is not for you simply relax under the palm trees at the Oasis of Kfar Hanokdim. The Oasis and its Bedouin camp will be our dinner and overnight stop, experiencing the Bedouin lifestyle sleeping in desert



lodges, or rustic cabins. For the early riser, why not find a quiet place outside the camp and watch the sun rise? Something you will always remember!

# Day 5 - Friday 2nd

We visit **Masada**, this fortress city was built by Herod and is one of the most important historical sites in Israel. The cable car takes us to the plateau with its stunning views across to Jordan and the Land of Moab. After, we will continue driving north past En Gedi, the Dead Sea (the lowest place on earth) and Jericho to the **River Jordan** where the Israelites cross into the Promised Land the site of Jesus' baptism. Final destination - **the Sea of Galilee**. The rest of the afternoon is free to swim or just chill.

Dinner and overnight Galilee - 3\* hotel.

## Day 6 - Saturday 3rd

This morning will follow 'Jesus' teaching Triangle'. we visit **Capernaum** the centre of Jesus' ministry, **Chorazin** and **Bethsaida** the site for the feeding of the 5000.

Back to the hotel, free afternoon for swim.

Dinner and overnight Galilee.



# Day 7 - Sunday 4th

Galilee is such a peaceful place, you will understand why Jesus spent so much time here. The morning starts with a relaxing boat trip across the **Sea of Galilee**, imagine Jesus walking on the water or calming the storm. We say goodbye to Galilee by visiting **St Peters Primacy** the traditional beach location where Jesus appeared to Peter after his resurrection.

On our journey to the airport we will stop at the Mediterranean beach resort of **Caesarea** where you can take a quick swim or enjoy the beach cafes, a great place to finish the trip.

This is a 'taster' tour for younger people and first timers, although people who have been before are welcome.

There will be quite a lot of walking so a degree of fitness is essential.

### Room Check In and Check Out Times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 10am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.

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
