

## ITINERARY

### **Day 1, Thursday**

#### **London / Tel Aviv**

We depart from Gatwick airport on our flight to Tel Aviv.

On arrival we will be met and transferred to our hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

### **Day 2, Friday**

#### **Mount of Olives / Western Wall / Bethlehem**

We drive from Bethlehem to the top of the Mount of Olives, the place of Jesus' ascension, to admire the spectacular views of the Old City of Jerusalem and the City of David. We walk down the Palm Sunday Road to Dominus Flevit, recalling how Jesus wept over the city, and continue to the Garden of Gethsemane, the Southern Wall excavations and the Western (Wailing) Wall.

In the afternoon we visit the Bethlehem Bible College and the Shepherds' Fields. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

### **Day 3, Saturday**

#### **Old City / Mount Zion**

This morning we enter the Old City of Jerusalem, beginning our tour at the Pool of Bethesda and the Church of St. Anne. We continue to the site of the Antonia Fortress, where Jesus was tried by Pilate, and then to the Jewish Quarter.

In the afternoon we visit Mount Zion and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, identified as the site of the house of the High Priest Caiaphas and the dungeon where Jesus may have been imprisoned during his Jewish trials. Here Peter denied knowing Jesus.

Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

### **Day 4, Sunday**

#### **Masada / Qumran / Dead Sea**

Today we visit Herod's hilltop fortress of Masada, ascending and descending by cable car, and continue to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered by a shepherd boy. There will be an opportunity to swim or float in the Dead Sea before returning to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

### **Day 5, Monday**

#### **Garden Tomb / Jericho / Galilee**

We visit the Garden Tomb for a communion service before leaving Jerusalem for Jericho to see the ancient city and to ascend the Mount of Temptation by cable car. We travel north along the Jordan Valley to the baptismal site at Yardenit and then to our hotel in Nazareth for dinner and overnight.

## Day 6, Tuesday

### Sea of Galilee / Gamla / Banias

This morning we take a memorable boat trip on the Sea of Galilee, stopping for a time of worship on the lake. Passing the wilderness area of Bethsaida we drive to Gamla, the Zealot command post in the Galilee during the Jewish Revolt. We continue through the Golan region to Banias and the area of Caesarea Philippi.

Dinner and overnight in Nazareth.

## Day 7, Wednesday

### Nazareth / Capernaum / Mount of Beatitudes

We start the day in Nazareth, the town of Jesus' childhood, to visit the outstanding Nazareth Village, depicting life in the time of Jesus, and the Mount of Precipitation with its magnificent panorama of the Jezreel Valley.

In the afternoon we visit the Mount of Beatitudes, Jesus' adopted home town of Capernaum and the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter, commemorating Jesus' feeding of the 5,000 and his resurrection appearance by the lake.

Return to Nazareth for dinner and overnight.

## Day 8, Thursday

### Jezreel Valley / Caesarea / Journey Home

We leave Galilee and travel via Mount Carmel and the Jezreel Valley to Caesarea for a media presentation and to see the Roman aqueduct and amphitheatre en route to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight to Gatwick.

### PASSPORTS, VISAS AND VACCINATIONS

Travellers are responsible for ensuring that they have a valid passport for travel to the relevant countries and that it is valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel. Visas are not required for British passport holders visiting Israel. At the time this brochure was sent to press no vaccinations or inoculations are required for travel but you may wish to consult your own doctor for advice concerning this. If you have any queries regarding the above, we will be happy to help.

### FURTHER INFORMATION AND PAYING THE BALANCE

Further information will be sent to you regarding any action that may be required approximately 12 weeks

before departure.

A final invoice will also be sent at this time and the balance for the tour must be paid at least 10 weeks before departure.

### TRAVEL INFORMATION

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties.

### TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is compulsory to have travel insurance for your booking. Holiday Extras have a range of policies available at very competitive prices. ### GRATUITIES

Our normal procedure is to deal with tips on a group basis and these are included in the price. The tour leader will distribute them to the guide, driver and hotels on your behalf. Individual tipping is not recommended unless the circumstances are exceptional.

### ROOM CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT TIMES

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 11am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.
