Day 1 - London / Tel Aviv

We depart on our flight from London to Tel Aviv. Meeting and assistance upon arrival and transfer to our hotel in Tel Aviv for dinner and overnight.

Day 2 - Nazareth / Cana / Mt. Tabor

We visit Mount Carmel and then to the Church of the Annunciation and Nazareth Village. Travel to Cana of Galilee where Jesus performed his first miracle by turning water into wine at a wedding feast. Those who wish can renew their marriage vows. In the afternoon we drive to Mount Tabor where the Lord was transfigured, which we will ascend and descend by taxis before we drive to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 - The Sea of Galilee

After breakfast we take a boat trip across the Sea of Galilee. The boat will stop on

the lake if you wish to have a brief service.

We will first visit Capernaum "the Town of Jesus" where he carried out the major part of his Ministry and Messianic Work. Visit the excavations and St. Peter's Church. Visit Tabgha, the site where the Lord fed the 5,000 with five loaves and two fishes, and the Mount of Beatitudes which commemorates our Lord's Sermon on the Mount. Finally we visit Bethsaida.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 4 - Jericho / Jacobs Well

Today we leave Galilee and visit the baptism site at Yardenit on the River Jordan where there will be the opportunity to be baptised before driving to Shechem and Jacob's Well. After returning from Mesopotamia Jacob bought a plot of land for "a hundred pieces of silver" where he pitched his tent and dug

a deep well. Jesus spoke to the Samaritan woman here. Our next stop will be in Jericho. View the ancient city and take the chair lift to the Mount of Temptation before we continue to the Inn of the Good Samaritan and then to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 - Bethlehem / Shepherds' Fields

In the morning, we visit the Church of the Nativity and the Grotto, venerated as the Birthplace of Jesus. We drive to the Shepherds' Fields where we have a service. The remainder of the day is free in Bethlehem. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 6 - Mt. of Olives / Mt. Zion

After breakfast we visit Bethany where we visit Lazarus' tomb and then continue to the Mount of Olives where we have a panoramic view over the Old City. Walk down the Palm Sunday road to the chapel of Dominus Flevit, where the Lord wept over Jerusalem. Finally descend to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. In the afternoon visit Mount Zion and the Upper Room, also known as the Cenacle which commemorates the Last Supper and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu on the sight of the house of the High Priest Caiaphas and see the Dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 7 - The Way of the Cross

This morning we visit the Western (Wailing) Wall and then continue to the Southern Wall excavations and the steps. We cross the Temple Mount where we see the Dome of the Rock and continue to the Crusaders' Church of St. Anne and the Pool of Bethesda. We walk to the Tower of Antonia where Jesus was tried, visit the Church of the Flagellation and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre before we return to our hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 - Masada / Dead Sea / Qumran

Today we drive to Masada to visit Herod's hill top fortress. We ascend and descend by cable

car. We then enjoy the experience of bathing in the Dead Sea. Finally, we visit Qumran where the Dead Scrolls were discovered before returning to our hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

Day 9 - David's City / Free afternoon

This morning we visit the excavations at David's City.

Free afternoon for shopping in the Old City. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 10 - Tel Aviv / London

Coach to Jerusalem for communion service at the Garden Tomb before transferring to the airport in the afternoon for return flight to London.

Passports, Visas and Vaccinations

Further information will be sent to you regarding any action that may be required approximately 12 weeks before departure.

A final invoice will also be sent at this time and the balance for the tour must be paid at least 10 weeks before departure.

Travel Information

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties.

Travel Insurance

It is compulsory to have travel insurance for your booking. Holiday Extras have a range of policies available at very competitive prices.

Gratuities

Our normal procedure is to deal with tips on a group basis and these are included in the price. The tour leader will distribute them to the guide, driver and hotels on your behalf. Individual tipping is not recommended unless the circumstances are exceptional.

Room Check In and Check Out Times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 11am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.
