2021 Itinerary

DAY 1 SUNDAY

We depart on our day flight to Tel Aviv. Check into our Hotel - Overnight Jerusalem 4* hotel.

DAY 2 MONDAY

Bethany - Jesus often stayed here with His friends Lazarus, Mary and Martha, and was anointed here with oil before His crucifixion. You will have the opportunity to go down into the traditional tomb where **Jesus raised Lazarus** from the dead.

Herodium in the Judean hills, site of the recently discovered tomb of King

Herod. We visit the **Shepherd's Fields** overlooking **Bethlehem**.

Bethphage - (the House of Unripe Figs). The disciples were sent here to collect the donkey that Jesus would ride into Jerusalem to fulfil the prophecy of Zechariah.

Mount of Olives - with its spectacular views across the Kidron Valley and Jerusalem.

Palm Sunday Road - retracing Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem and visiting Dominus Flavit (where Jesus wept over Jerusalem).

Garden of Gethsemane to consider Jesus' last 24 hours. We continue down through the **Kidron Valley** past **Absalom's Pillar** and the towering walls of the Temple Mount above.

DAY 3 TUESDAY

This full day walking tour starts at the **Golden Gate** where Jesus entered the Temple on His Triumphal Entry and through which He will walk on His return. We enter the

Old City through **The Lions Gate**, from here Jewish troops recaptured the Old City during the 6 Day War in 1967.

Following the Via Delarosa to the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus healed the crippled man.

Western Wall Tunnel archaeological site of 1st century Jerusalem at its best, get within a few metres of the site of the 'Holy of Holies'.

Next to the **Western Wall** (Kotel) where you can pray, or just absorb the atmosphere of this unique place.

Southern Wall Excavations of the Temple Mount – we will stand on the steps Jesus used to enter the Temple. This site brings together archaeology, history and the Bible, something never to be forgotten.

Lunch time in the **Jewish Quarter**.

Church of St Peter in Gallicantu on **Mount Zion** where he denied his friend Jesus three times. From here we can see the original steps Jesus walked up, from the Lower City (City of David) to the **House of Caiaphas** the High Priest, to be tried.

Dinner and overnight – Jerusalem.

DAY 4 WEDNESDAY

Today starts at the **Garden Tomb** and the **Place of the Skull** where we share Communion and consider the importance of what took place here.

Friends of Zion Museum where we meet the biblical figures, academics, businessmen, and military officials who, through their faith, have forged an everlasting bond between the Jewish and Christian peoples. The presentation is magnificently told using ground-breaking technology, and interactive displays that appear to come to life before your very eyes.

Our next stop is the city of **Arad** with spectacular views across the Negev desert. We continue east to the **Judean desert**, and the **Oasis of Kfar Hanokdim** where those wanting to make the most of the desert experience will take a short camel trek into the wilderness. Experience the Bedouin lifestyle sleeping in desert lodges, or rustic cabins. For the early riser, why not find a quiet place outside the camp and watch the

sun rise, something you will always remember?

The Oasis and its Bedouin camp will be our dinner and overnight stop.

Day 5 THURSDAY

After an early morning breakfast, we visit the **Fountain of Tears** sculpture display that parallels the sufferings of Jesus with the Jewish Holocaust, very moving and thought provoking.

We drive to **Ein Bokek Beach** for a 'must do' thing in Israel, a float in the **Dead Sea** the lowest place on earth, if this is not for you just relax and take in the wonderful scenery.

Continue north through the **Jordan Valley** for our next stop at the **River Jordan** where the Israelites cross into the Promised Land and the site of Jesus' baptism.

Final destination - **the Sea of Galilee**. The rest of the afternoon is free to swim or just chill.

Overnight in Tiberius.

Day 6 FRIDAY

Kursi (across the Jordan River). It was in this region that Jesus landed on his first missionary journey into Gentile territory and cast evil spirits out of the demon possessed man.

Teaching Triangle Tour –

Capernaum the Centre of Jesus' ministry, **Chorazin**, and **Bethsaida** where Jesus and his disciples fed the 5000.

Magdala and the recently excavated 1st century Synagogue, Jesus most likely taught here during His time in Galilee.

The site celebrates the role of women as it's the home of Mary Magdalene, a dedicated follower of Jesus.

Back to the hotel for a relax or swim.

Overnight in Tiberius.

Day 7 **SATURDAY**

Today half day tour follows part of Jesus' third missionary journey through the **Golan Heights**.

Caesarea Philippi, here the disciple Peter made the great confession that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the Living God.

Fortress Nimrod on Mount Hermon. From here you can see across to Lebanon, Syria and Jordan - a spectacular view.

Mount Bentel overlooking Syrian border, Saul came this way on the road to Damascus.

Back to the hotel for a relax or swim.

Overnight in Tiberius.

Day 8 **SUNDAY**

Mount Tabor- following the snake path to the traditional site of the Transfiguration.

Walk the road into **Nain** - where He raised the widow's only son.

The final stop will be **the Precipice at Nazareth** which is overlooking the Jezreel Valley from here the Synagogue leaders attempted to throw Jesus over the edge.

Free half day.

Overnight in Tiberius.

Day 9 **MONDAY**

The day starts with a boat trip across the **Sea of Galilee**, picture Jesus calming the storm and walking on the water.

Next to **St Peter's Primacy** on the Sea of Galilee. Here after His Resurrection Jesus met the disciples, fed them breakfast and commissioned Peter to "*feed my sheep*".

Our final stop on this amazing trip is the **Tel Aviv** port of **Namal** - an area full of culture, entertainment and leisure activities. It has a huge promenade running along the seafront full of shops trendy restaurants and cafes' just a great place to wind down before our return flight home.

There will be quite a lot of walking so **a degree of fitness is essential**.

Passports, Visas and Vaccinations

Travel Information

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties.

Room Check In and Check Out Times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 10am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.

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
