Day 1 - London / Tel Aviv

We depart on our flight from London Luton to Tel Aviv. Meeting and assistance upon arrival and transfer to our hotel in Nazareth for dinner and overnight.

Day 2 - Nazareth / Cana / Mt. Tabor

This morning we visit the Nazareth Village depicting life as in the times of Jesus. We drive to Cana of Galilee where Jesus performed his first miracle by turning water into wine at a wedding feast.

In the afternoon we visit Mount Tabor where our Lord was Transfigured, which we will ascend and descend by taxis before returning to our hotel in Nazareth for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 - Capernaum / Sea of Galilee

We drive to Capernaum visit the Mount of Beatitudes which commemorates our Lord's Sermon on the Mount, Capernaum, "The Town of Jesus" where he carried out a major part of his Ministry and Messiani work and see excavations and St. Peter's

Church. Tabgha, the site where our Lord fed the 5,000 with five loaves and two fishes. We end the day with a boat trip on the lake.

Dinner and overnight in Nazareth.

Day 4 - Jericho / Bethlehem / Shepherds' Fields

Today, we leave Galilee and drive along the Jordan Valley Road to Jerusalem. On the way we visit Jericho. Continue to the baptism site at Qaser el-Yahud on the River Jordan where there will be the opportunity to be baptized.

We visit the Church of the Nativity where we see the star and the Shepherds' Fields.

Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 5 - Dead Sea / Qumran

We leave early to visit Qumran and then Masada before enjoying the warm waters of the Dead Sea.

The remainder of the day is free.

Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 6 - Jerusalem / The Way of the Cross / Garden Tomb

This morning we shall enter the Old City and start our tour at the Crusaders' Church of St. Anne and the Pool of Bethesda. Continue to the Tower of Antonia where Jesus was tried and the Church of the Flagellation. We visit the Western (Wailing) Wall where we will spend some time. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - Jerusalem Mt. of Olives / Mt. Zion

After breakfast we visit Bethany where we visit Lazarus' tomb and then continue to the Mount of Olives where we have a panoramic view over the Old City. Walk down the Palm Sunday Road to the chapel of Dominus Flevit, where our Lord wept over Jerusalem. Finally descend to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations.

In the afternoon visit Mount Zion and the Upper Room, also known as the Cenacle, which commemorates the Last Supper; the Dormition Abbey, and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu on the site of the house of the High Priest Caiaphas and see the Dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned. We end the day with a visit to the Garden Tomb for a communion service. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Day 8

FREE DAY in Jerusalem for shopping. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Tel Aviv / London

This morning we visit Jaffa before the coach takes us to Tel Aviv airport for our return flight to London Luton.

Travel Information

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties.

Travel Insurance

It is compulsory to have travel insurance for your booking. Holiday Extras have a range of policies available at very competitive prices.

Gratuities

Room Check In and Check Out Times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 11am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.
